


The event starts promptly at 7 PM PT, be sure to test out your sound and video beforehand

How to Participate in the Silent Auction

Register

You must register to place bids, purchase merchandise or make a donation.

By Desktop, Tablet or Smartphone

- 3. Choose amount Use the pre-populated minimum bid or enter a higher amount.
- 4. Auto bid Select AUTO BID, enter the highest amount you are willing to bid. The system will place minimum bids for you, as needed, until your designated amount is reached
- 5. Click Bid.



Silent Auction FAQs

How can I quickly sort through the auction packages?

At the top of the Items page, you will see a "Category" tab. Click this tab to see a list of package categories (décor, trips, family friendly, etc.) and select the category you want.

After I bid on a package, how do I know if I have the leading bid?

After you place your first bid, you will be notified by text message if someone outbids you. The text message will include a link that will take you back to the auction site to place another bid, if you so choose.

How do I review my purchases?

To review what you've purchased and process your payment, please go to the "Pay" tab. Otherwise, we will process all credit cards on file for all winners when the auction closes at 12 PM Pacific Time on Sunday, November 22, 2020.

What if I accidentally bid on or buy an item?

You will need to contact us right away at 323-229-1798, so we can remove your bid. Please note, refund requests received after the auction closes at 12 PM Pacific Time on Sunday, November 22, 2020 cannot be processed.


How do I collect my package(s)?

Your Donations at Work: Pandemic Aid



In Summer 2020, the Foundation donated 500 infrared thermometers to firefighters in New Mexico in partnership with the New Mexico Fire Protection Grant Council.

The New Mexico Fire Marshal's Council oversaw distribution to every fire station throughout the state. These thermometers provide rapid results without body contact, allowing firefighters and paramedics to quickly—and safely—assess their potential risk for COVID-19 exposure while delivering assistance during emergencies.

"Our firefighters were experiencing high call volumes that placed members at increased risk of exposure to the virus," said Robert E. Larrañaga, Chairperson of the New Mexico Fire Protection Grant Council. "We express sincere gratitude to the Fire Family Foundation for their efforts in protecting our firefighters."

Your Donations at Work: Disaster Relief




In response to the devastating fires in Northern California in August 2020, the Fire Family Foundation sent disaster relief kits to firefighters on the front lines.


