Eligibility

I certify that I (check all that apply; must meet all criteria to be eligible):

- Am the biological or adopted child of any active, retired or fallen firefighter within the United States;
 - Am a senior in high school or over the age of 16 with a GED, or currently enrolled in a community college, university as an undergraduate, or trade school;
 - Have a current GPA of 3.2 or above;
 - Am under the age of 26; and
- During the academic period for which a scholarship is requested, be either (A) a candidate for an undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited college or university, or (B) a full-time or part-time student at an educational organization that is nationally accredited and legally authorized to offer the educational program, including vocational schools.

Application Instructions

1. Download the PDF application from FireFamilyFoundation.org/Scholarships.
2. Save to your computer.
3. Complete the application by typing your responses directly into the PDF file. If you have downloaded and saved the application to your computer, you have the ability to save and resume working on your application at your own pace.
4. Save the final PDF once your application is complete.
5. Write your essay in a separate file.
6. Complete the submission page application located at FireFamilyFoundation.org/Scholarships.
7. Upload the following items as separate files:
 - Application
 - School Transcript
 - Resume
 - Essay
8. When you submit your application, you will get a notification that your application was successfully received. We will contact you after reviewing your application package.

To ensure the Scholarship Committee understands the important points you are making, strive to express yourself clearly, using proper grammar, spelling and punctuation.

School has been particularly stressful for many students during the pandemic. What has been the most difficult part for you, and what steps have you taken to overcome this difficulty and ensure your academic success? Has having a firefighter parent influenced your actions or attitude?
